Mr. Jayant Chaudhary, Hon'ble Minister of State for Skill Development and Entrepreneurship of the Government of India will be visiting the Kingdom of Morocco leading the Indian delegation to the 3rd Edition of GITEX Africa being held in Marrakech from 14-16 April 2025. The Indian delegation would also include several tech-based startups from the Indian State of Karnataka.

During the visit to Morocco, Mr. Jayant Chaudhary will meet his counterpart in the Moroccan Government, H.E. Dr. Amal El Fallah Seghrouchni, Minister of Digital Transition and Administrative Reform and other Ministers. Mr. Jayant Chaudhary will also participate in the panel discussions of GITEX Africa, including one on “Empowering Societies through Digital Public Infrastructure: Insights from India to Morocco and Africa”.

The bilateral relations between India and Morocco are multifaceted based on strong cooperation in several areas of mutual interest including trade and investment, fertilizer, defence manufacturing, training and education.
