Embassy of India Organises "Connect with India 2026" in Casablanca

The Embassy of India in Rabat successfully organised "Connect with India 2026" on 19 July 2026 at Le Méridien Casablanca, bringing together over 130 members of the Indian diaspora, representatives of the Kingdom of Morocco, business leaders and distinguished guests for an evening celebrating community, culture and the enduring friendship between India and Morocco.

The event commenced with the National Anthems of the Kingdom of Morocco and the Republic of India, symbolising the close bonds of friendship and mutual respect between the two countries.

Welcoming the gathering, Mr. Amit Get, First Secretary, Embassy of India, underlined the objective of the initiative to strengthen the Embassy's engagement with the Indian diaspora in Casablanca, foster greater community interaction and celebrate India's rich cultural heritage.

Addressing the gathering, H.E. Mr. Sanjay Rana, Ambassador of India to the Kingdom of Morocco, shared the Embassy's recent initiatives, achievements and future plans for enhancing engagement with the Indian community in Morocco. He also briefed the diaspora on key Government of India initiatives, including the recent Overseas Citizen of India (OCI) reforms, the Know India Programme for youth of Indian origin and opportunities available through GIFT City. The Ambassador encouraged greater participation of the Indian community in strengthening the India-Morocco Business Chamber and welcomed the idea of establishing an India Professional Network in Morocco to further enhance professional and business collaboration.

Highlighting the significance of the year 2027, when India and Morocco will commemorate 70 years of diplomatic relations (1957–2027), the Ambassador reaffirmed the commitment of both countries to further deepen cooperation across political, economic, commercial, cultural and people-to-people exchanges.

The programme also featured remarks by Mr. Dev, Regional Head, Satguru Travel; Mr. Madouli Oussama, General Manager, Le Méridien Casablanca; and Mr. Colin Nebhwani, representative of the India-Morocco Business Chamber, who emphasised the importance of stronger business partnerships and deeper engagement between the Indian diaspora and Moroccan stakeholders.

A vibrant cultural programme formed the highlight of the evening, with Moroccan artists performing patriotic Indian songs, popular Bollywood numbers and energetic dance performances. Their enthusiastic participation reflected the deep appreciation for Indian culture in Morocco and the strong cultural affinity shared by the people of the two countries.

Guests also enjoyed an elaborate culinary experience featuring more than 80 Indian and Moroccan delicacies, showcasing the rich gastronomic traditions of both nations.

The evening concluded with the live screening of the FIFA World Cup Final, bringing together members of the Indian diaspora and Moroccan guests in a festive atmosphere of friendship, camaraderie and shared celebration.

"Connect with India 2026" reaffirmed the Embassy's commitment to strengthening its engagement with the Indian diaspora and promoting the growing India–Morocco partnership. As both countries prepare to celebrate the 70th anniversary of diplomatic relations in 2027, the event served as a meaningful platform to reinforce the enduring friendship, vibrant cultural exchanges and strong people-to-people ties that continue to define bilateral relations.
